Fire Level 1 (Basic), Fire Level 2 (Intermediate), Fire level 3 (Crew Leader)

Employment Opportunities Program (Skill Development)

This course includes a pathway towards a fire warden with flexible stages from basic to crew leader.

The Course: (Basic)

- Identify workplace hazards and risks and advise others
- Implement hazard control procedures
- Follow and implement of OH&S
- Personal protective equipment (PPE)
- Prepare to respond to fire

Duration of Program: 1 Day



The Course: (Intermediate)

- Prepare to respond to fire
- Proceed to fire
- Obtain and use extinguishing media and equipment
- Combat wildfire
- Participate in mop-up and patrol activities
- Recover and store equipment

Duration of Program: 3 Days

The Course: (Crew Leader)

- Incident response and proceed to incident
- Assess the incident
- Plan and implement an operational response to the incident
- Supervise post-response activities
- Report on incident
- Contribute to team activities
- Give and receive support to/from team members

Duration of Program: 6 Days
