



## Emergency Rescue and Response Level I

The Workplace Skills Development Certificate in Emergency Response and Rescue Level I reflects the role of anyone working in non-medical sector with added responsibility and is required to participate as first responder in any emergency situation within the workplace or community in accordance with organisation safe work practices.

Workers in this role may be required to provide a first aid response in a range of situations, including, remote sites, community and workplace settings as well as play a key role in maintaining health and safety in an organisation, including duty of care for other workers
