The Workplace Skills Development Level 1 OHS reflects the role of an entry level worker or existing employed workers.

This program has been designed to provide initial skills to allow a worker to work safely and prevent injury or harm to self and others. It covers identifying and orally reporting common construction hazards, understanding basic risk control measures, and identifying procedures for responding to potential incidents and emergencies. It also covers correctly selecting and fitting common personal protective equipment (PPE) used for construction work
