Emergency Rescue and Response Level II

The Workplace Skills Development Certificate in Emergency Response and Rescue Level II reflects the role of anyone working in any work place with added responsibility to participate as first responder in any emergency situation within the workplace or community in accordance with organisation safe work practices.

Workers in this role may be required to provide first aid response, and first response firefighting duties in a range of situations, including, remote sites, community and workplace settings as well play key role in maintaining health and safety in an organisation, including duty of care for other workers
