

Certificate in Medical Support Services Level II

The Workplace Skills Development Certificate in Medical Support Services Level II reflects the role of non-medical health support personal who is required to participate in safe work practices to maintain safety of the worker(s), the people being supported and other community members and assist in an emergency situation.

Workers in this role may be required to provide a first aid response in a range of situations, including community and workplace settings as well acquire knowledge of workplace health and safety (WHS) to carry out their own work, in both centre-based and home-based service provision
