

Emergency Rescue and Response Level III

The Workplace Skills Development Certificate in Emergency Response and Rescue Level III reflects the role of anyone working in a work place with added responsibility to participate in an emergency situation within the workplace or community and in accordance with organisation safe work practices.

Workers in this role may be required to work as emergency services officers and/or participate in various emergency situations or incident scenes in workplaces, communities or industries. ESOs might be required to provide first aid response apart from other response disciplines, in a range of situations, as well play key role in maintaining health and safety of everyone within the emergency response team.

Content of Course:

- Communicate emergencies in the workplace
- Provide safe extrication in water/pool Prevent injuries
- Dangerous Goods and handling emergency
- Provide medical emergency response Follow health and safety policies and procedure
- Provide first aid
- Prepare and using rescue equipment's Follow safe work practices
- Lead response team
- Support for rescue operation
- Work safely at heights and rescue
- Enter and work in confined spaces and rescue
- First Response Fire Fighting L2 Hazardous Incident and response
