Certificate in Medical Support Services Level III

The Workplace Skills Development Certificate in Medical Support Services Level III reflects the role of non-medical health support personal who is required to implement and monitor health and safety (WHS) policies, procedures and work practices as part of a small work team and assist in an emergency situation whenever required.

Workers in this role may be required to provide a first aid response in a range of situations, including, remote sites, community and workplace settings as well play key role in maintaining health and safety in an organisation, including duty of care for other workers

This program has been designed with the input of PNG industry and specialist and defined as a community and industry need for those individuals and clients that are not professionally trained in the health sector that support:

- Doctors
- Paramedics
- Nurses
- Health posts
- Remote areas and communities
- Emergency Services

Content of Course:

- Contribute to workplace procedures for identifying hazards and controlling risks
- Implement policies and procedures into work team processes
- Support consultation, cooperation and communication
- Respond to an emergency situation
- Apply appropriate first aid procedures
- Manage the incident.
- Evaluate the incident and own performance.
- Coordinate first aid activities until arrival of medical assistance.
- Communicate details of the incident.
