Emergency Rescue and Response Level IV

The Workplace Skills Development Certificate in Emergency Response and Rescue Level IV reflects the role of anyone working in a work place with added responsibility to Control in an emergency situation within the workplace or community and in accordance with organisation safe work practices.

Workers in this role will be required to work as emergency services officers and/or participate in various emergency situations or incident scenes in workplaces, communities or industries. ESOs might be required to provide first aid response apart from other response disciplines, in a range of situations, as well play key role in maintaining health and safety of everyone within the emergency response team.

- SOLAS Training (Safety of life at sea)
- Incident Cause Analysis Method (ICAM WSD PNG)
- Rehabilitation and Return to Work (RRTW WSD PNG)
- International Maritime Dangerous Goods Handling (IMDG WSD PNG)
- Emergency Evacuation Procedures
