The Workplace Skills Development WSD30220 Certificate III Medical Support Services PNG reflects the role of non-medical health support personal who are required to implement and monitor health and safety (WHS) policies, procedures and work practices as part of a work team and assist in an emergency situation whenever required.

Workers in this role may be required to provide a first aid response in a range of situations, including, remote sites, community and workplace settings as well play key role in maintaining health and safety in an organisation, including duty of care for other workers. This role may assist a health medical team.
